Beech Island Rural Community Water and Sewer District Users:

An election will be held this year to fill one position for our Board of Directors. Each position carries a six-year term to begin September 2025 and runs through election day of September 2031.

Qualified users interested in filing for the director position must submit their name in person at the District Office by May 27, 2025. Hours of operation are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Wednesday 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. The office will have a candidate submission form for your convenience. You will be issued a copy of the election rules as well as a copy of Director's duties as set forth by the District's by-laws when you submit your name.

To qualify as a candidate, a person must be 18 years old on or before the day of election and a resident user of the Beech Island Rural Community Water and Sewer District service area. The candidate's water/sewer account must be current with no disconnections or bad debts against the account.

The advisory biennial election will be held on Tuesday, September 16, 2025 in accordance with the by-laws of the District to elect either the incumbent or a new Director. Each water/sewer user on the records of the system as of September 1, 2025 will be entitled to one vote for each water/sewer meter in service.

Voting hours will be between 12:00 noon and 7:00 p.m. at the District Office located at 630 Beech Island Ave, Beech Island SC and Pine Forest Baptist Church located at 2829 Pine Log Rd, Warrentonville SC. Your water bill account number will determine your voting location. All account numbers are printed on your monthly water bill.
