Election Rules

To serve as a Director of the Beech Island Rural Community Water and Sewer District (BIRCWSD), a person must have a meter registered in their personal name or spouse's name for one year prior to the election and must be a resident of BIRCWSD.

Eligibility is dependent on the account with the proposed individual being in good standing, which is hereby defined as having the water bill paid current. Further, the proposed individual must not have been on the cutoff list or on the bad debt list with BIRCWSD for the past two calendar years.

The candidate's name must be submitted to the Secretary of the District before the 4th Monday in May prior to the Biennial Election. The Biennial Election of Directors will be held on the 3rd Tuesday of September.

- 1. Voting shall take place at a designated location in the BIRCWSD area and at a designated location in the Piney Heights Community.
- 2. Voting hours will be from 12:00 noon to 7:00 p.m.
- 3. Each meter will be allowed one vote.
- 4. No voting proxy will be allowed.
- 5. Voting for meters registered in the names of churches, lodges, etc. shall be done by the Secretary, Treasurer, or a designee of the organization.

The name(s) of the Director(s) elected will start serving immediately and such names will be recommended to the Aiken County Council for approval and forwarded to the South Carolina Governor for appointment.
